

SPRINGVILLE TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MEETING  
OCTOBER 16, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl, at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Clyde Kastl, Sharon Ream, Geraldine Kastl, Mickey Sparks, and Beverly Walton. Public present: Ben Townsend.

The September 18, 2017 meeting minutes were read and approved.

No public comment.

Clyde Kastl reported that the Minar Cemetery has some damage to the fence and possible damage to headstones from a fallen tree from adjacent property. Clyde talked to property owner and he does not accept responsibility and does not have resources to take care of this. John Larsen gave a quote of \$975 to clean up the tree mess. Clyde made a motion to accept John Larsen's bid for tree cleanup, motion seconded by Beverly Walton. Motion carried. Clyde will call John to let him know to go ahead and do the work.

Clyde Kastl also reported that the furnace repair was done by Dave's Electric and was a blown fuse. The repair cost was \$50.

Sharon Ream gave an update on the recently acquired hardware building. Architect bids are due by November 10, 2017, and getting many inquiries thru phone and website. No bid proposals have been received as yet. Discussion followed obtaining a 20-yard dumpster to get started on interior cleanup. We would need to recruit volunteers from the community to help with this.

Sharon Ream submitted a letter from Hometown Decorations regarding Christmas decorations and the 2017 season in Mesick. This is the 3rd and last year per the agreement with the Village of Mesick and sharing in the cost. Sharon will be contacting the Village for interest in renewing for future years.

Mickey Sparks made a motion to pay invoices submitted. Motion was seconded by Beverly Walton. Motion carried.

Sharon Ream made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Beverly Walton.
