

SPRINGVILLE TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MEETING  
MARCH 19, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl, at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Clyde Kastl, Sharon Ream, Geraldine Kastl, Mickey Sparks, and Beverly Walton. Public present: Luanne Adams, Tammy & Dave Spencer, Ben Townsend, and Garry Jewett.

The February 19, 2018 meeting minutes were read and approved.

Tammy and Dave Spencer presented an application for Industrial Facilities Tax Exemption in the amount of \$373,348. This amount represents the cost of renovation and addition to the existing Mesick Mold Building to include Office area, Engineering Room, File Room, and Conference Room. Sharon Ream made a motion to accept the application and to do the necessary processing for the State of Michigan. Motion seconded by Mickey Sparks. Motion carried.

Garry Jewett discussed the 911 grant application submitted to the Federal Government for the upgraded system. He has not received any information from the grant request as yet. Clyde requested that Garry have an extra key made for Clyde's access to Garry's Office. Discussion followed regarding the James Carpenter mobile home fire. Mr. Carpenter submitted a request for the fire report to submit to his insurance company. Garry provided the report to Sharon and she will mail to Mr. Carpenter.

Clyde Kastl reported on the tankless water heater information and that it will be adequate for multiple showers if needed. Jim Mori will install at a cost of \$250 for labor. Cost of the water heater will be about \$2000.

Clyde Kastl reported that the Board of Review Members did a great job this year. New member, Keith Hoover, fit in well and will be a good addition to the board.

Ben Townsend reported that the book on Springville Township is complete and is scheduled for release May 19, 2018. A book signing is scheduled at the Mesick Historical Museum May 19, 2PM to 4PM and will be advertised around town.

Beverly Walton made a motion to pay invoices submitted, seconded by Geraldine Kastl. Carried.

Gordon & Deb Stafford submitted a request to hold the annual Jeepers event May 5, 2018. Motion was made by Geraldine Kastl and seconded by Beverly Walton to allow the Jeepers event for May 5, 2018 and keep the donation the same as in past years. Motion carried.

A spring cleanup was discussed. Dave Williams, Wexford Twp, had contacted Clyde about a joint cleanup with Wexford Twp. Dave was not present at the meeting and Clyde will contact him to discuss.

Sharon made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Beverly Walton.
