

SPRINGVILLE TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
APRIL 16, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl, at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Clyde Kastl, Sharon Ream, Geraldine Kastl, Mickey Sparks, and Beverly Walton. Public present: Gary and Luann Adams, Dave Williams, Ben Townsend, and Garry Jewett.

Old Business:

Dave Williams was present from Wexford Township to discuss the proposed Spring Cleanup event to be held June 16 from 8AM to Noon on the Springville Township property. American Waste has quoted bill rates for a truck with driver @ \$115/hr for port to port. Compacted yard cost is \$30 per yard. They will furnish a tire container and a metals container. There is a possibility of a fuel surcharge if fuel cost is over \$3.50/gallon. Clyde Kastl will check on the tire cost before the brochure is sent out. Wexford Township will share the cost of the event at 50%.

105 E Mesick Ave building update: Allee Costalles is checking on a cleanup crew for 4/28 and Sharon will check with American Waste on a dumpster. The Village of Mesick will be removing the existing sign in the near future.
