BOARD MEETING

MAY 21, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl, with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 PM. Present: Clyde Kastl, Sharon Ream, Geraldine Kastl, Mickey Sparks, and Beverly Walton. The April 16, 2018, meeting minutes were read and approved.

Public Comment: Dave Hendler opened discussion with complaints of the Putney property problems. They are hosting loud parties and have multiple vacation units being set up on the property. Others attending voiced similar complaints and concerns about Zoning regulations. Ben Townsend work for the Wexford County Joint Planning Commission and he informed the residents that a site visit will occur on Friday, May 25th for review of the situation in relation to zoning violation possibilities.

Old Business: Sharon Ream reported that the Clean-Up brochures are almost ready for mailing. There is no new report for the 105 E. Mesick Ave. property situation.

Motion was seconded by Mickey Sparks. Carried.

Sharon Ream read a letter of resignation from treasurer, Geraldine Kastl and made a motion to accept the resignation of Geraldine Kastl as Treasurer to be effective May 22, 2018. Motion seconded by Beverly Walton. Carried.

Sharon Ream made a motion to appoint Diane Stanton as the interim treasurer, seconded by Clyde Kastl. Carried.

Beverly Walton made a motion to appoint Cheryl Schenden as Deputy Treasurer, seconded by Clyde Kastl. Carried.
