

SPRINGVILLE TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
JUNE 18, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl, at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Clyde Kastl, Sharon Ream, and Beverly Walton. Absent: Diane Stanton and Mickey Sparks. Public present: Ben Townsend, Jessica Boonstra, Cheryl Schenden, Gary and Luann Adams.

The May 21, 2018 meeting minutes were read and approved.

Old Business:

Clyde Kastl reported on the Cleanup Day held Saturday, June 16, 2018. Approximately 80 Springville Twp residents participated as well as over 40 Wexford Twp residents. 4 - 25 yard compactors were on site with Bryon Guthrie present to collect metal and tires. Many volunteers helped to make the day a big success and Clyde recommends that we do this next year.

Sharon Ream reported that the State of Michigan has put a hold on the new Chart of Accounts requirement for the time being. A decision is in the process deciding if the requirement will be mandated to small townships.

Clyde Kastl reported that he is working on the details for the sale of the dump trailer and other unused equipment owned by the township. Sharon will advertise in the paper and we will keep the equipment in the pole barn where it is currently housed since the flat tires make it difficult to move.

Ben Townsend reported on the Putney property complaints from the May meeting. He visited the property and spoke to property owner, Mr. Putney, explaining the multiple violations with the warning that failure to comply with the zoning restrictions may result in attorney involvement. Ben consulted with the DEQ, Health Dept, Licensing Dept, and other entities.

Sharon Ream made a motion to renew the AT&T Metro Act Right of Way Permit Extension presented by mail from AT&T. Motion seconded by Beverly Walton and carried.

New Business:

Diane Stanton informed Sharon Ream that she is unable to perform the duties of treasurer for personal reasons. Sharon Ream made a motion to appoint Cheryl Leatherman as interim treasurer, seconded by Beverly Walton. Carried.

Sharon Ream made a motion to appoint Diane Stanton as interim deputy treasurer, seconded by Clyde Kastl. Carried.

Sharon Ream made a motion to approve training expenses associated for the new treasurer to become familiar with BS&A software and tax collecting. Motion seconded by Clyde Kastl and carried.

The 2018-2019 General Fund Budget was discussed. Beverly Walton made a motion to approve the 2018-2019 General Fund Budget presented, seconded by Clyde Kastl. Carried.

The 2018-2019 Fire Department Budget was discussed. Beverly Walton made a motion to approve the 2018-2019 Fire Department Budget presented, seconded by Clyde Kastl. Carried.

Sharon Ream made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Beverly Walton. Motion carried.
