

SPRINGVILLE TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
JULY 16, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl, at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Clyde Kastl, Sharon Ream, Cheryl Leatherman, Mickey Sparks, and Beverly Walton. Public present: Ben Townsend, Jessica Boonstra, Diane Stanton, John Summey, and David Fox.

The June 18, 2018 meeting minutes were read and approved.

Public comment: David Fox, Wexford County Commissioner District 3 Republican candidate was present to discuss his candidacy with the board.

Clyde Kastl updated the status of getting the equipment ready for sale. With the condition of the trailer, mowers, and equipment, we will leave it in the maintenance building at the Sherman-Mesick Memorial Cemetery for potential bidders to assess. We are waiting on the details such as model numbers, serial numbers, and starting bid amount for publication in the newspaper.

Sharon Ream presented Primary Election Workers for approval and payment after the August 7th election. Sharon made a motion to authorize Cheryl Leatherman, Chairperson, Ruth Harris, Debby Townsend, and 3 others to be named and to pay directly after the election including mandatory training held July 25th. Motion seconded by Beverly Walton. Carried.

Mesick Rescue Squad submitted a request for a 2.25 millage increase to be placed on the November 6th ballot. This would be added to the current .75 millage in place to raise the millage to 3 mills. Much discussion followed. Clyde Kastl made a motion to place the up to 2.25 millage increase on the November 6th ballot. No second was offered and the motion stopped for lack of support. It was decided to contact North Flight EMS to be more informed on the issues and to make a decision regarding this. A Special Meeting will be held Thursday at 7:00 PM, July 26th with North Flight. Sharon will post the meeting by July 18th for the public to attend.

Cheryl Schenden reported that she needs a printer for the tax rolls n working with Wexford County Treasurer's office. This would be included with the initial authorization to get equipment to update the Treasurer's computer and software.

Beverly Walton made a motion to pay invoices submitted, seconded by Mickey Sparks. Motion carried.

Mickey Sparks made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Beverly Walton.
