

SPRINGVILLE TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MEETING  
OCTOBER 15, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl, at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Clyde Kastl, Sharon Ream, Beverly Walton, Mickey Sparks. Absent: Cheryl Leatherman. Public present: Jim Peterson, John Summey, Laura Cuffaro, Gary Adams, Ben Townsend, and Jessica Boonstra.

The September 17, 2018, meeting minutes were read and approved.

Public comment: None

Old Business: Clyde reported that all equipment has been paid by purchasers and removed from the township storage barn. Total collected was \$2,525.20.

New Business: Sharon Ream presented a Noise Ordinance for review to aid in the noise/disturbance issue at the entrance of Northern Exposure. Beverly Walton made a motion to adopt the Noise Ordinance as presented. Motion was seconded by Mickey Sparks and carried.

Ben Townsend explained a correspondence and resolution from the Wexford Joint Planning Commission for adopting. Other townships have already passed it and it relates to storage unit construction on M-115 across from the Timbers Restaurant. Sharon Ream made a motion to approve the resolution, motion seconded by Clyde Kastl. Carried.

A notice was received from Huntington Bank informing the area that they have made the decision to close the Mesick Branch Office. After discussion on how this will work for the township, Sharon Ream made a motion to move the General Fund and Tax Accounts to Honor Bank. Motion seconded by Clyde Kastl. Carried.

Ben Townsend reported that he has been working closely with Randy from the Cherry Grove Fire Department in filing paperwork for grants for our fire department. We will keep the fire department accounts with Huntington since the application requires bank routing and account number and the time-frame for the application is not conducive to making that change at this time.

Sharon Ream reported that there is much work to be done in the Mesick cemetery and has a bid from John Larsen to do some tree cleanup. Beverly Walton made a motion to have John do the cleanup, motion seconded by Mickey Sparks. Carried.

Sharon Ream made a motion to approve Election Workers as follows and to pay them after Election Day: Cheryl Leatherman, Chairperson, Jessica Boonstra, Mary DeKorne, Viva Kastl, Nancy Shimek, & Beverly Walton.

Beverly Walton made a motion to pay invoices, seconded by Mickey Sparks. Carried.

Jim Peterson from the Rescue Squad was present and reported that they will be holding another Community Awareness Open House for Saturday, October 20<sup>th</sup> at 3PM.

Mickey Sparks made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Beverly Walton.
