BOARD MEETING

NOVEMBER 19, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl, at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Jessica Boonstra read the resignation letter from Sharon Girard. Sharon stated in the letter that she would be resigning from her position as clerk, to be effective December 1st, 2018. Beverly Walton motioned to accept Sharon's resignation. Cheryl Leatherman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Cheryl Leatherman motioned to appoint Jessica Boonstra as the Springville Township clerk. Beverly Walton seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Beverly Walton motioned to pay invoices. Mickey Sparks seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Beverly Walton motioned to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Kastl seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 PM.
