

SPRINGVILLE TOWNSHIP
REGULAR BUSINESS MEETING MINUTES
June 15th, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM by Supervisor, Clyde Kastl.

Board Present: Clyde Kastl, Jessica Boonstra, Wendy Floury, Beverly Walton, Scott Neuffer, and Deputy Supervisor Ben Townsend.

The Pledge of Allegiance was Recited.

Scott Neuffer motioned to accept the May 18th, 2020 Meeting minutes. Beverly Walton seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There was no Public Comment.

In New Business, Jessica Boonstra motioned to discuss the proposed General Fund Budget for the new fiscal year. Wendy Floury seconded the motion. The board discussed the proposed budget. Scott Neuffer motioned to accept the proposed Fire Department Budget. Jessica Boonstra seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken: Supervisor Kastl-Yes, Jessica Boonstra-Yes, Wendy Floury-Yes, Beverly Walton-Yes, Scott Neuffer-Yes. Vote was passed 5 Yeas and 0 Nays.

Jessica Boonstra shared that our Fire Chief, Garry Jewett had stepped down as Fire Chief. We are currently looking for a replacement Fire Chief. There is an ad in the newspaper for 2 weeks. Jessica Boonstra shared that Mickey McDill is willing to work with Travis Baker from Wexford County Dispatch on reporting data and the capabilities of "I am Responding." There are reports that he can directly input information into NFIRS. He is willing to help out in this area with Board approval. Wendy Floury made a motion to allow Mickey McDill to help the department with the I am Responding tool through this time. Jessica Boonstra seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jessica Boonstra shared that there are renovations needed to make the Fire Barn more functional. More will be discussed at the Fire Department meeting on Wednesday.

Wendy Floury motioned to pay the invoices for June. Beverly Walton seconded the motion. Motion carried.

In our second Public Comment, Mike Guernsey shared that Buckley Fire Department is willing to help our department when needed through this time.

Todd Hoskins shared that he and Tom Stagg would be meeting with the Buckley and Colfax Fire Chiefs to share ideas and get input.

Supervisor Kastl shared that the Spring Clean-up is pushed to September 19th.

Scott Neuffer motioned to adjourn the meeting. Beverly Walton seconded the motion. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:10PM.
